I am requesting funding for the Neighborhood Revitalization Efforts project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Miami, located at 444 SW 2nd Ave, Miami, FL 33130.

The funding would be used to provide the city with federal support to continue its efforts in community revitalization throughout the City of Miami.
